The training that will take place will be conducted over a period of four days. The topics that will be covered are as follows:

Day 1: OC Aerosol Projector Instructor Course

This course entails:

Day 2: Chemical Munitions Instructor Course

All instruction will be conducted in a classroom setting. Practical work will be conducted at an approved range. Inert training rounds will be used for classroom demonstration. All students attending this class will be required to have a calculator, notebook, pen and pencil, as well as safety equipment such as Nomex type gloves, earplugs, and glasses. It is recommended that attending officers wear either tactical B.D.U.'s or casual dress clothing and bring their departmental issued 12 gauge less-lethal deployment systems. Class time will be from 8:00 AM to 4:00 PM each day and a mandatory test will be given at the end of each topic covered.
